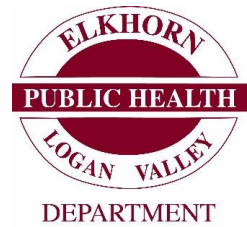
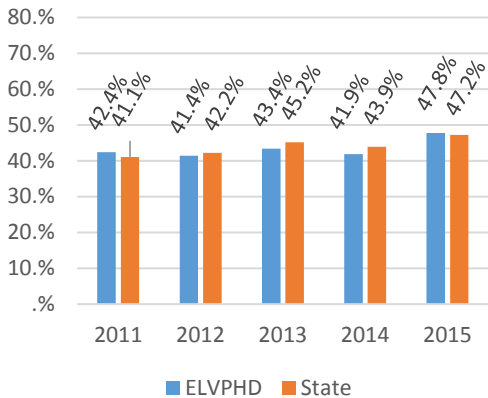


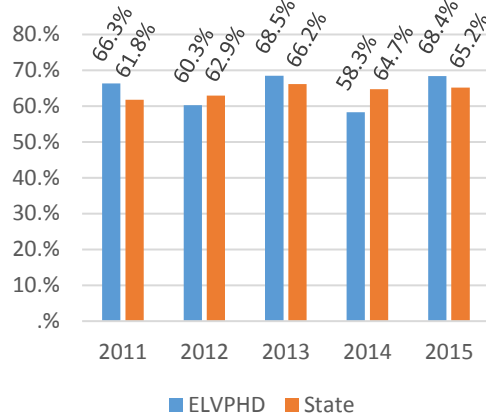

Why it Matters:

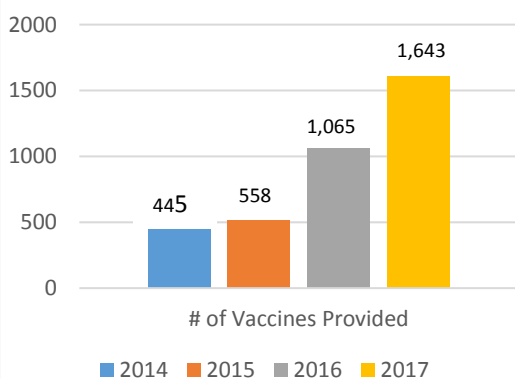
Vaccines are one of the best ways to protect yourself from some diseases like influenza, pneumonia, and others. The CDC advises that everyone gets a flu shot every year. The Healthy People 2020 goal is to raise flu shot rates so that 70% of the public gets the shot each year. For those aged 65 and older, the goal is set at 90%.

Elkhorn Logan Valley Public Health Department provides vaccination services throughout the year as well as at many businesses during the flu shot season. The graphics below show the total number of vaccines provided by ELVPHD from 2014-2017 and the total number of people served with immunizations during the same period. ELVPHD provides immunizations daily at the Wisner and Norfolk offices. Immunizations are provided by appointment and there are extended hours to accommodate those who are unable to attend traditional day-time hours. ELVPHD also provides satellite clinics in West Point and Madison every-other-month.

How ELVPHD is helping:

ELVPHD's vaccination program has grown, from giving 445 immunizations in 2014 to 1,643 vaccines given in 2017. ELVPHD is a provider for the Vaccines for Children (state-funded vaccine) program and also serves those with Medicare, most major insurances and private-pay clients. The VFC program was new at ELVPHD in 2017 and allows for children who are uninsured or underinsured to receive immunizations at no cost to the families.
